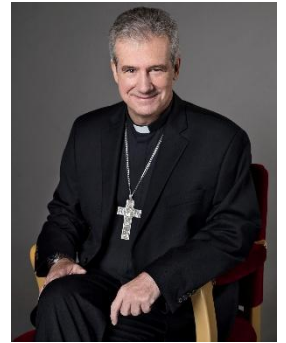

## ST. MARK, EVANGELIST FEAST DAY APRIL 25.

St. Mark is the author of the Second Gospel, writing in Greek between 50 and 60 A.D. Mark joined St. Paul and St. Barnabas on their first missionary journey to Antioch in 44 A.D, and when Paul was first imprisoned, Mark visited him as one of his trusted companions (Col 4:10). St. Mark lived for years in Alexandria, where he died as a

martyr while being dragged through the streets. St. Mark's symbol is a winged lion, and he is often depicted as writing or holding his Gospel.

“He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice”  
(Jn. 10)
