CELEBRATING SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST IN QUÉBEC



It was on St John the Baptist's Day that Mass was first celebrated on the Island of Montréal on June 24, 1615, on the banks of Rivière des Prairies. Samuel de Champlain was on his seventh voyage to Canada. The priest celebrating was Fr. Denis Jamet, assisted by Fr. Joseph Le Caron. Unbeknownst to them at the time, they were celebrating what was to be the first Mass for the Patron Saint of Québec.

This Catholic feast day celebrating the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist has evolved into a massive patriotic celebration of French-Canadian and Québécois culture, language, and heritage. Throughout the fun and the celebration, let us remember John the Baptist the Saint, who leapt in Elizabeth's womb when she was visited by Mary, who baptized

Jesus in the River Jordan, who instructed his followers to turn to Christ, calling Him the "Lamb of God", and who gave his very life pointing people toward Christ.
